Facts about Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPPs)



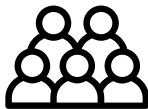
A CWPP identifies wildfire hazards in at-risk communities. The plan outlines risk assessment and strategies for reducing those wildfire hazards.



Sublette County approved a CWPP in 2011 and 2016. In 2021-2022, the county will be updating its plan.



Most Sublette County residents have homes that face direct exposure to wildfire risk.



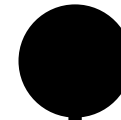
A CWPP helps identify community partners who can collaborate together to reduce the risk.
