

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

OCTOBER 20, 2020

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the Marbleton town Hall on this date at 9:00 A.M. with David Burnett, Joel Bousman, Mack Rawhouser, Doug Vickrey, Tom Noble, Clayton Melinkovich, Matt Gaffney, Holly Dabb, representing the Pinedale Roundup, and Carrie Long, County Clerk, present.

Chairman Burnett led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the agenda with the addition of a Visitor Center Board request to be added to the Administrator's segment. Motion carried.

The minutes of the preceding meeting held on October 6 were approved and ordered filed by motion from Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner Rawhouser. Motion carried.

Billy Pape, Road & Bridge Superintendent, updated the Board on activities.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Bousman to waive the dump fees for the Upper Green Cemetery District for the disposal of a building. Motion carried.

Mike Jackson and Eric Sackett, Rio Verde Engineering, updated the Board on activities. Mike Jackson reported the Hoback Drainage Mitigation project was complete.

It was moved by Commissioner Rawhouser, seconded by Commissioner Noble to allow the Town of Marbleton to upgrade the Food Pantry building with CARES Act money. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Vickrey to approve the Request for Proposals as presented by Matt Gaffney for the upgrade to the telecommunications system. Motion carried.

Mary Lankford, Janet Montgomery and Betty Fear updated the Board on the activities of the Centennial Committee.

Matt Gaffney advised the Board he would be submitting additional CARES Act funding request from 8 different entities in the amount of \$836,572. It was moved by Commissioner Bousman, seconded by Commissioner Vickrey to approve the request. Motion carried.

Commissioner Noble volunteered to serve on the Visitor Center Board for a period not to exceed six months. Commissioner Rawhouser made a motion to approve the appointment, seconded by Commissioner Vickrey. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman, seconded by Commissioner Rawhouser to approve an amended contract between Sublette County and the Wyoming Department of Health regarding CARES Act funding. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve accounts payable. Motion carried.
